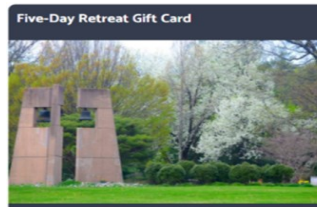

## Retreat Gift Cards Now Available

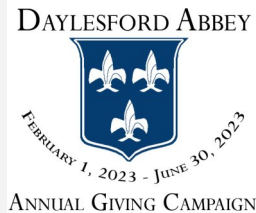

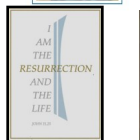
