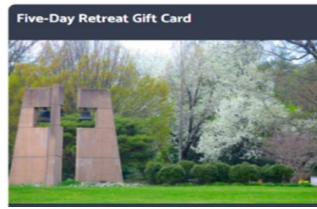

All requests remain on the list for one month. You may reinstate or remove a request by calling to inform us. **Thank you for praying for the people on this list!**

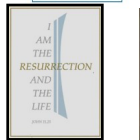
